Fourth Grade

1 3-ring binder

1 small pencil sharpener w/shavings collector, no electric sharpeners please
Supply of pencils, (traditional wood & graphite) no mechanical pencils please

Please help your student organize their bags and backpacks so that supplies and other essentials like lunches or jackets fit within. Do not bring toys or stuffed animals to school.
